Prayer Diary - February 2015

Sunday 1st We pray for the Unite volunteers' social, that this time will bind this group's strong ties while we wait for the Lord's next move, after the completion of yfc@park.

Monday 2nd:- Thank God, for the young adults at Over 18s as they meet tonight to deepen their understanding of His will for their lives.

Tuesday 3rd:- Thank God for the way Alison has been accepted in G.Y.H.S in the lunchtime; may she know His leading.

Wednesday 4th:- Praise the Lord for the Youth Café. Also the number of high schools represented. Give those leading, the power of Your authoritative love in any tensions that may arise. Pray also for Alison in Art1 at G.H.Y.S. today.

Thursday 5th:- May the Holy Spirit open heart and minds of the young people Alison meets in the G.Y.H.S dinner hall this lunchtime.

Friday 6th:- Thank God for the volunteers He has provided and their desire, for the young people of this town to know Jesus. Pray that He may send others who can help during the working day. We also pray for Alison as she starts a week's holiday; may she know God's peace.

The Weekend:- We pray for the young people who are left to fend for themselves and often their siblings during the day; may they find You and rest in Your love.

Monday 9th:- Pray for the youth of Great Yarmouth as a new week of school starts and for those who travel to another 6 high schools due to the lack of places at G.Y.H.S

Tuesday 10th:- Hold close to our hearts, those young people who are isolated due to school friends being too far away in the evening. Pray they will be included by those who go to G.H.Y.S.

Wednesday 11th:- Ask for God to move in the lives of the young people at the Youth Café; that they may want to know Jesus - the one who will always be ready to listen to them. Thank God for the Unite team who give the human ear and Christ's love to them.

Thursday 12th:- Thank God for our trustees and the time they give to Unite. Pray that He will move in the hearts of 2 more people so that they will come forward with other gifting.

Friday 13th:-As the schools break for half term ask the Lord to bless the staff as they plan for the period leading to Easter; may they ask for new light on the subject and receive the love of Jesus for themselves.

Weekend:- Pray for Mettle on Sunday that God will guide and bless Nigel L & Alison as they lead this group; thank Him for the young people He has sent and pray that more will want to join with the group to find out what the Lord longs to show them of His plans for them.

Monday 16th:- Pray that the Holy Spirit will move on the young people and their families; that tensions dissipate; that families and those on school holiday will be protected from the plans of the devil, and that they feel the power of prayer and seek Jesus.

Tuesday 17th:-Thank God for Unite prayer at Newtown Methodist tonight (7.45pm); pray that He will move hearts to pray for ALL the work with the young people of Yarmouth.

Wednesday 18th:- Focus Monday's prayer over the Byron Road estate.

Thursday 19th :- Focus Monday's prayer over the Middlegate estate.

Friday 20th :- Focus Monday's prayer over the Barrack estate.

Weekend :- Seek the Lord to send those young people who have had their hearts moved through our prayers this week to cross the path of Your servants to further their understanding.

Monday 23rd:- Thank God for Alison's willingness to disciple those at Over 18s tonight and that all will be blessed by taking part tonight.

Tuesday 24th:- Hold Alison before God, as she returns to the G.H.YS. this lunchtime .that those whom the Lord chooses will be drawn into conversation with her.

Wednesday 25th :- As the Youth Café opens after the break ask that our prayers last week over these young people from different schools, will bring new harmony to this group.
Pray also for Alison in Art 1 at G.H.YS. today.

Thursday 26th ;- Pray for the Lord to create opportunity in the dinner hall today, for Alison to show His love and care to staff, employees as well as students.

Friday 27th:- We ask the Lord to be with all the youth of the town as the school week ends and to protect them by the power of His loving Spirit.
