

## East Norfolk Youth for Christ (Unite) Prayer Diary - March 2015

"You faithfully answer our prayers with awesome deeds, O God our Saviour.

You are the hope of everyone on earth, even those who sail on distant seas."

(Psalm 65 v 5)

Sunday 1<sup>st</sup>: We pray for the rearranged meeting of Mettle tonight, that all involved will feel the loving leading of the Spirit, as it draws them closer to the Lord's plan for their lives.

Pray for Nigel as he delivers the message about Joseph's life.

Monday 2<sup>nd</sup>: As the Over 18s meet tonight, thank God that He faithfully hands the message of His love from generation to generation

Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup>: Thank God for the way Alison has known God's leading in her role in the High School – every time she gets nervous and doubts her role God guides and encourages her (*Prayer Diary on 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2015*)

Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup>: Pray that the young people who are usually at the Youth Café will come to trust Jesus who will always love them and never fail them in their troubled lives. Pray that they will find something constructive to do as the café is closed again due to lack of volunteers.

We also ask that the Lord will go before Alison, preparing the hearts of the pupils she will sit with in Art1 at GHYS.

Thursday 5<sup>th</sup>: May the Holy Spirit move in power in the dinner hall, as Alison faithfully goes in today.

Friday 6<sup>th</sup>: As the weekend arrives we ask God's Spirit to work in the hearts of the young people who have been in contact with His people this week. Pray for encouragement and inspiration for Alison as she meets with other YFC Directors at Norwich today.

The weekend: We thank the Lord that as we pray, the Holy Spirit will protect the youth of this town from the works of the enemy, over all aspects of their lives.

Monday 9<sup>th</sup>: Pray for the schools which do not have Alison going in; that the Christians who are in them will be strengthened, as their lives show your love. Thank God for the young Christian adults who yearn for more of God's Spirit and teaching at Over 18s.

- Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup>: As Alison sits in the dinner hall today, guide those whom you chose to share their joys and problems with her.
- Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup>: We thank God for the way He has answered our prayers for the tensions in the group to ease. Please pray for wisdom as the young people open up to those who lead.

  Also that Alison will feel the Lord's blessing in Art1 at high school.
- Thursday12<sup>th</sup>: We pray for those who will be exposed to drugs at school and at home; that the Lord will protect them from harm and give them the strength to say no.
- Friday 13th: We pray for all young people who this weekend will not have a loving family around them this Mother's Day. There are a surprising number of teenagers who live with their fathers nowadays and don't see their mothers very often at all, but also for those whose mothers have passed away.
- Weekend: Pray for the trustees as they take some time together to pray for the Lord's leading for the work He wants Unite to undertake in the months ahead. Pray for vision and clarity for the next steps. We also pray for Mettle on Sunday and thank God for the new young man who has joined the group. (*Prayer Diary 15<sup>th</sup> Feb 2015*)
- Monday16<sup>th</sup>: We ask that the Holy Spirit's power will be felt as the Over 18s meet tonight to learn more via Francis Chan's "Basic" series about the significance of Communion in our daily lives.
- Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup>: Thank God for Unite prayer at Newtown Methodist tonight (7.45pm); pray that He will move hearts to pray for ALL the work with the young people of Yarmouth. Also for Alison and the young people you send to talk to her today in the dinner hall.
- Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup>: As the Youth Café meets again pray they will know the depth of Jesus love for them. Also remember Alison in Art1 today as she tries to open up conversations with the students.
- Thursday 19th: May the love of our Lord be so real in the dinner hall today that the staff and pupils will not be able to ignore it.
- Friday 20<sup>th</sup>: Thank the Lord for His provision of volunteers, and their heart for serving the young people of this town. May He pour His richest blessings on their lives as they live for Him. Pray that they will know what to volunteer for and commit to.
- Weekend: Pray for the young people who will be getting ready for their last term at school after Easter; that they will come to know Jesus for their walk through life.
- Monday 23<sup>rd</sup>: Pray for Alison and the Over 18s tonight as they pray together and encourage each other. As the first "cut-off" date for Newday bookings draws near pray for the planning and the organisation of all the different young people and their leaders. Pray that there will be provision for all the young people whom God wants to be there this year.
  - Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup>: Thank God that He never wastes the time Alison is in the dinner hall; He always knows the task set and provides the words needed for His servants.

Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup>: As the Youth Café meets for the last time before Easter, pray that the young people be sure of God's love and be eager to return when it reopens. Keep Alison and all she will meet in Art1 close to the Saviour's love in prayer.

Thursday 26<sup>th</sup>; Pray that as Alison goes into the dinner hall for the last time this term,she will have the openings to share the love of Jesus. Thank Him for the way she has been able to share His love already with certain members of the dinner hall staff.

Friday 27<sup>th</sup>: We ask the Lord to bless the staff and pupils as they break for Easter; that the Spirit will show them Jesus in whom is true rest.
